Citizens of Milan,

On Thursday, March 12th Governor Bill Lee declared a state of emergency in Tennessee. Governor Lee said that this was an important next step in the state's efforts to treat and mitigate the impact of the coronavirus on the citizens of Tennessee. The City Government of Milan is taking preliminary action to protect the citizens of our community. You will begin to notice signs on all municipal buildings asking for you to call before you enter if you have flu like symptoms.
