In light of continued COVID-19 safety concerns, the City of Milan has decided not to open Milan City Pool for the 2020 swimming season.

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), there is no evidence that COVID-19 can be spread through properly treated water. However, there is a definite concern that the virus could still be spread in the restrooms, on pool ladders, slide, and pool lounge chairs. Consequently, it would be extremely difficult to enforce the proper social distancing during aquatic activities to ensure swimmer safety.

Based on these and many other factors, it has been determined that in the interest of public health the pool will not be open for the summer of 2020.
