

Reserve Firefighter

Minimum Qualifications Include:

High School Diploma, GED or Senior in high school with confirmation of ability to graduate

Pass a Criminal History Background Check

At Least 18 Years of Age

Good Physical Condition

U.S. Citizen

Valid Tennessee Driver's License

Pass Drug Screen & Physical Exam

The applicants are to complete the following:

1. Agility test with Ladder Climb (10:00 time accepted for initial test but must complete in 9:00 within 6 months)
2. Drug Screening and Physical
3. Background check
4. Orientation including review of operation procedures for the department
5. Review and schedule training (dates and times)
6. Review of City of Milan and Milan Fire Department rules and regulations concerning Reserve Firefighters

Reserves will complete both the 16 and 64-hour firefighter basic training and have a live burn before being able to work shifts or respond to All-Calls for the department unless they possess proof that they have already been through that training.

Reserve Pay

Reserve Firefighters will be paid a minimum stipend.

Reserve Gear Issue

Reserve Firefighters will be issued new PPE including turn-outs and wildland firefighting gear.

Reserve Training

Reserves will receive free firefighting and emergency medical training.
