<u>Party times available:</u> Monday – Friday at the following times: 6-8PM and 8-10PM. Saturday party times 10AM -12PM and 5PM – 7PM. Sunday times 7PM-9PM.

**Pricing:** 2-hour parties - \$200 – to be paid in full 2 weeks prior to date of party. This includes up to 25 people swimming. Each swimmer over 25 must pay \$2 per person. If party is cancelled due to inclement weather, another date can be rescheduled if available or a refund will be issued.

## **Pool party rules:**

- 1) Only children's birthday parties (up to age 13), Business employee appreciation parties and Church or School group parties are allowed at the Milan City Pool.
- 2) No outside entertainment or music is allowed to be used in association with pool parties. The Pool has a radio and speakers that can be used for parties.
- 3) Only non-profit parties are allowed at the City pool. No gate collection is allowed for parties.

## **Pool Rules:**

- 1) No outside food or drinks (excluding parties)
- 2) No diapers allowed in pool
- 3) No coolers
- 4) No alcohol
- 5) Swim suits are required if swimming in the pool
- 6) Children under 10 must be accompanied by someone 16 years of age or older
